

# Watercolor on Yupo Workshop

Explore the possibilities of watercolor painting on this unique surface. Yupo is a slick and non-absorbent synthetic paper. These properties allow the colors to remain bright and vibrant and to flow and blend differently than on traditional watercolor paper. Interesting patterns and watermarks are created, paint can be pushed around and lifting is easy.
